The Road Commission Board as well as the Rose Lake Township Board have reviewed and discussed the informal petition complaining about the road conditions in the Rose Lake Forest and neighboring subdivisions. As explained in the past the Road Commission's long standing policy for improvement to roads within a subdivision requires funding by sources other than the Road Commission general budget. It is our understanding the Township wide millage only raises roughly \$50,000 which is not nearly be enough to cover the cost necessary for the desired improvements in the "Forest" subdivisions. The only likely scenario to achieving your desired outcome would be through the development of a Special Assessment District (S.A.D.). A brief explanation of the S.A.D. process is included in the enclosed attachment.

Based on discussions with the Township and the comments in the summarized history provided with the petition, we have developed a very rough estimate for two road improvement options:

Option 1: Resurface the main Forest Trail loop and the route to the south out to 155th Avenue including portions of Section Line Rd, Shores Dr, Deer Run and Oak Ridge Drive, roughly 3.16 miles. The estimated cost to simply shape up and pave the existing road with NO other improvements (i.e. culverts, ditches, clearing, drive approaches, etc.) would be \$501,000.

Option 2: In addition to those roads in Option 1 would be to include Hills Circle to the west and Osceola Lodge and S. Plateau Circle to the southwest, an additional 2.04 miles for a total improvement project of 5.2 miles. The estimated cost to simply shape up and pave the existing road, again with NO other improvements would be \$814,000.

Please advise the Road Commission and/or Township in writing if you wish to pursue the development of an S.A.D., keeping mind the final cost will vary from the estimates above depending the level of improvement desired and which roads are improved.
